The meeting will include a presentation by Gross-Wen Technologies (GWT) on the design, operation, and performance of the algal-based wastewater treatment pilot plant in Dallas Center and tour of the installation. GWT is commercializing an algal based wastewater treatment process that recovers nutrients (nitrogen and phosphorus) from wastewater. The biomass that is produced can then be used as a slow-release fertilizer. The meeting will begin at 2:00 pm with a presentation on the pilot plant and will conclude with a tour of the facility.
